#### Granger Guidelines

- Regular Curby cart trash collection includes cart + 3 extra trash bags on outside of cart. Trash bags may not exceed 33-gallon size/30-lbs per bag.
  - Small Curby trash collection includes cart only.
- 6-Bag trash collection includes 6-Bags only. Trash bags may not exceed 33-gallon size/30-lbs per bag.
  - Personal containers and loose trash will not be collected.
- Residents are responsible to prepay for extra trash bags and/or bulk items at standard rates. Extra trash and/or bulk items that have not been prepaid for by resident(s) will not be collected.
- Requests for more than 1 Regular or Small Curby trash cart per address must be made by Cadgewith Farms. No discount for additional units.
- Residents do not have the option to establish individual trash, recycle or yard waste accounts with Granger.
