It's key that our office has the most up to date emergency contact information for you. If we have a old number and something happens, we have nobody to contact. It only takes a minute to call the office (517) 371-1101 or drop a note in our drop box with your name, address and emergency contacts name/phone number (we have room for two emergency contacts).

Now that the snow has arrived, please read the snow plowing information below. It's really important to have all cars off the roadways when we plow. Having the road clear from obstacles helps maintenance completely clear roadways. Also you may want to wait to clear the ends of your driveway until the plows have gone past. Depending on the amount of snow and the amount of time maintenance has, determines if they come back and plow out ends of driveways. If you lived in the city or township this is never done. So please remember we do this out of courtesy and can't always be expected to do so.

We've had reports that drivers aren't moving over for walkers and are coming within arms length of them. This is unacceptable and unsafe. Please give walkers plenty of room when going around them.

Please bring an extra set of shoes to change into when going to the gym. This will help prevent salt being brought in and puddles accumulating.

Snow Plowing Information

It's that time of year again, when the snow begins to fall and needs to get removed from the roads. Here's some helpful reminders:

- * **Overnight parking on the road is not allowed, especially during or after a snow storm**
- * **During daytime snow fall events, please make an effort to park off roadways**
- * **Please do not approach the plow truck by car or in person, contact the office if you have a question or concerns**
- * **When shoveling or snow blowing your driveway please don't put snow back into the road, instead into your lawn**
- * **Ends of driveways may or may not get plowed by Cadgewith Farms, depends on the amount of snow received and the amount of time our maintenance crew has. This is done as a courtesy and can't be expected.**
- * **Any damages done to your lawn will be addressed in the spring**
