Dewitt Township Police Warn Of New Scam

The Dewitt Township Police Department wants to warn all residents of a new type of scam that is being sent to individuals' email accounts. The scam advises the recipient that they have been issued a traffic citation for a violation which needs to be taken care of through the local Department of Motor Vehicles. The email directs the recipient to click on a link in order to make payment. This is NOT how Dewitt Township Police, or any other law enforcement agency in Clinton County, issues traffic citations. THIS IS A SCAM. Police advise anyone receiving these types of messages to not click on the link to make payment and to just delete the email. This does not need to be reported to law enforcement unless you actually provide payment and are a victim. There are many email scams that are sent out to potential victims which are constantly being dealt with by law enforcement. Here are some tips to help everyone get through these types of crimes:

1. Never give anyone your computer password
2. Avoid opening unsolicited attachments
3. Do not ever blindly click on links
4. If you do click on an unsolicited link and if you are directed to a sign in page, DON'T sign in
5. If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is
6. Never provide your personal details such as address, social security number or date of birth
7. Never provide any banking information
8. Be aware of any request asking for money or payment
